STATEMENT of REASON



THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS, BOROUGH OF SWALE) (WAITING RESTRICTIONS AND STREET PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT NO.32) ORDER 2022 Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

To facilitate the safe passage of vehicles, it is proposed to extend the double yellow lines on the south-western side of Cortland Close, Milton Regis, from the junction of Lammas Drive to the corner opposite Cortland Mews, and around the hammerhead at the end of the road.

Also to facilitate the safe passage of vehicles, it is proposed to extend the existing single yellow line on the eastern side of Church Road, Murston, by an additional 30 metres north of the northern boundary of Murston Hall.

It is proposed to formalise the existing disabled persons' parking bay outside 12 Gordon Avenue in Queenborough and 135 Shortlands Road in Sittingbourne. It is proposed to remove the existing disabled persons' parking bay outside 115 Park Road in Sittingbourne.

For the following purposes:

- To preserve or improve the amenities of the area through which the road runs;
- To avoid danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or to prevent the likelihood of any such danger arising;
- To facilitate the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians).

The Kent County Council, acting as the local traffic authority and in exercise of its powers under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1) and (2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 49 and 53 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, ('the Act') and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

A - This Order may be cited as "The Kent County Council (Various Roads, Borough of Swale) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) Amendment No.32 Order 2022" ('this Order') and shall come into force on the 15th day of April 2022.






Proposed Additional Double Yellow Lines - Cortland Close, Milton Regis
