3. Completed nomination papers must be delivered by hand to the Returning Officer or her Deputy at Swale Borough Council, at the address shown below, on any day from **Friday 10 November 2023** between 10am and 4pm Monday to Friday, but not later than **4pm on Friday 17 November 2023.**
4. If the election is contested, the poll will take place on **Thursday, 14<sup>th</sup> December 2023** between the hours of 7am and 10pm. This is the same day as the polls for the Swale Borough Council - Abbey Borough Ward by-election.
