ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER ACT 1984

The KENT COUNTY COUNCIL, acting as the Local Authority and in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 32, 35, 36, 45, 46, 47, 49, 53, 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Traffic Management Act 2004, and all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby proposes to make the following order:-

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on day of 2025 and may be cited as "The Kent County Council (Various Roads, Borough of Swale) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) (Amendment No.11) Order 2025" ("this Order")
- 2. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply to this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, "The Kent County Council (Various Roads, Borough of Swale) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2024" ("the Order of 2024") shall have effect as though:

STATEMENT OF REASONS

The Kent County Council as traffic authority intends to make the Order referred to above as shown on the drawing accompanying this document for the following reasons :-

- For avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising
- For facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians).
- For preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Kent County Council proposes to make an Order under Sections 1, 2, 32, 35, 36, 45, 46, 47, 49, 53, 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Traffic Management Act 2004, and all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act.

The effect of the Order is:

To facilitate the safe passage of vehicles, it is proposed to remove the two existing disabled persons' parking bays outside of the Baptist Church in Strode Crescent, Sheerness and extend the existing double yellow lines at this location.

In The Mall, Faversham, it is proposed to amend the times of the existing single yellow line on the east side of the road, near the junction of Nelson Street, from 8.30am-6.30pm Mon-Sat to 8.00am-6.30pm on all days to align the restrictions with the adjacent loading restrictions.

It is proposed to remove redundant disabled persons' parking bays outside 62 Whitstable Road and 14 Belmont Road in Faversham, outside 8 Connaught Road, 15 Epps Road, 9 Harrier Drive, 107/109 Shortlands Road, 13 Langley Road and 26 Springfield Road in Sittingbourne, outside 25 and 51 Invicta Road in Sheerness, and outside 20 Stanley Avenue in Queenborough.

It is also proposed to install new, or formalise existing, disabled persons' parking bays outside 56 Main Road, Queenborough (for 52 Main Road), outside 51A High Street and 23 Harold Street, Queenborough, outside 96 Marine Parade, Sheerness (for 92 Marine Parade), outside 67 James Street, 98 Broadway and 12 Wellesley Road, Sheerness, outside 64 Prince Charles Avenue, opposite rear of 1-2 Gaze Hill Avenue (in School Road), outside 15 Merlin Close, (for 14 Merlin Close), 36 Swanstree Avenue, 66 Periwinkle Close and 4a Shakespeare Road, Sittingbourne, outside 3 Meadow Close, Iwade, and outside 123 St Mary's Road (for 125 St Mary's Road) and 5/6 Garfield Place, Faversham.
