#### **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER ACT 1984**

The KENT COUNTY COUNCIL, acting as the Local Authority and in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 32, 35, 36, 45, 46, 47, 49, 53, 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Traffic Management Act 2004, and all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following order:-

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on 20th day of December 2024 and may be cited as "The Kent County Council (Various Roads, Borough of Swale) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) (Amendment No.4) Order 2024" ("this Order")
- 2. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply to this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, "The Kent County Council (Various Roads, Borough of Swale) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2024" ("the Order of 2024") shall have effect as though:

NOTICE is given that the Kent County Council hereby make an Order under Sections 1, 2, 32, 35, 36, 45, 46, 47, 49, 53, 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Traffic Management Act 2004, and all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act.

The effect of the Order is:-

- (a) To remove the redundant disabled persons' parking bays outside 35 and 39 Plantation Road in Faversham, outside 29 Acorn Street, 59 Berridge Road, 11 Meyrick Road and 13 Unity Street in Sheerness, in the Borough of Swale
- (b) To install new, or formalise existing, disabled persons' parking bays outside 10 Acorn Street and 6 Bredhurst Close in Sheerness, and 4 St Johns Avenue in Sittingbourne, in the Borough of Swale

Anyone may, by application to the High Court within 6 weeks of the date of publication of this Notice, challenge the validity of the Orders or of any provision contained in them on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or any instrument made thereunder, or that there has been a failure to comply with any statutory requirement to the Orders.
