ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER ACT 1984

1. This Order shall come into operation on day of 2026 and may be cited as “The Kent County Council (Various Roads, Borough of Swale) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order (Amendment No.3) Order 2026” (“this Order”)
2. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply to this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, “The Kent County Council (Various Roads, Borough of Swale) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2026” (“the Order of 2026”) shall have effect as though:
 - (a) Schedule 2 to the Order of 2026 is amended by the replacement or issue of the following Map Tile:

BW124 revision 1 replaced by	BW124 revision 2

NOTICE is hereby given that the Kent County Council proposes to make an Order under Sections 1, 2, 32, 35, 36, 45, 46, 47, 49, 53, 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Traffic Management Act 2004, and all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act.

The effect of the Order is as follows:-

In Court Street, Market Place and Middle Row in Faversham, it is proposed to install a Controlled Parking Zone with no parking at any time, from the junction of Court Street and Crescent Road to a point west of 1-2 Market Street;

In Court Street, Faversham, it is proposed to extend the operating times of the Residents' Parking Permit bays outside Nos. 17-24 Court Street, from Monday to Saturday to all days.
